

# Cathedral Palms Rules & Regulations

1. Check-out time is 11:00 a.m. **There is a \$5.00 late fee if rent is not paid by 11:00 a.m.** Check in time is 12:00 noon.
2. No loud talking, radio, television or other noise between 10 p.m. and 8 a.m.
3. **Speed limit inside the resort is 5 M.P.H.**
4. No vehicles may be unattended over 24 hours.
5. No tow vehicles or autos on grass.
6. Occupants are fully responsible for the conduct of their family members and guests in the park's facilities. Parents shall be responsible for any destruction of resort property by their children.
7. Children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult in the pool area. No infants in diapers are allowed in pools. Pool hours are 9 a.m. to 10 p.m.
8. Per health regulations, you must be 18 years or older to use the spas.
9. Floating devices, rafts or air mattresses are not allowed. Little tots may use arm flotation devices. Appropriate swimsuits only. No cut-offs or other street wear clothing in the pool or spa.
10. No glass containers, no running, no pushing, no diving, jumping or pets are allowed in the pool area.
11. Adult pool hours 9-10 a.m. and 4-6 p.m. No one under 18 allowed.
12. No more than six (6) people, whether or not they are members of the same family, may occupy one site.
13. Only one rig per site.
14. Motorcycles and mini-bikes may be permitted only from their rig to the outside of resort.
15. Clotheslines are not permitted, except for camper racks.
16. You **MAY NOT** save a site for friends or late arrivals or engage in any solicitation. **NO POSTED SALES BROCHURES.**
17. No repairs or oil changing on automobiles or RV's in the resort.
18. No washing of vehicles.
19. Children under the age of 14 are not permitted to use the pool table.
20. **Pets must remain on a short leash (6 ft.) at all times. Occupants are responsible for cleaning up after pets. Cathedral Palms reserves the right to exclude any pets who are noisy or left unattended outside of rig. Pets are to be walked in designated area in the resort.**
21. Occupants may receive packet mail while they are staying at the resort. **NO MAIL FORWARDING.**
22. Management is not responsible for loss due to fire, accident or theft, nor any loss, damages or injury to any resident or any guest of resident or any property of either.
23. \$3.00 extra for 50 amp service.

## POINTS OF INTEREST

**AGUA CALIENTE INDIAN RESERVATION:** Toll entrance to beautiful Palm and Andreas Canyons. Rich in historic/scenic wonder.

**DESERT MUSEUM:** Collection of history and art of the desert. 135 E. Tahquitz-McCallum Way, Palm Springs.

**JOSHUA TREE NATIONAL MONUMENT:** Cottonwood Springs Rd. off I-10. Unique desert foliage and scenery - many campsites.

**LAKE CAHUILLA:** Beautiful country park and recreation center. Fishing, picnicking, boating. Adjacent campground.

**LIVING DESERT RESERVE:** 3 1/2 miles of nature trails lead through plant gardens and oasis. Portola Ave., Palm Desert.

**DESERTLAND BOTANICAL GARDENS:** Display of 2000 varieties of desert plants. 1701 S. Palm Canyon Dr., Palm Springs.

**PALM SPRINGS AERIAL TRAMWAY:** Year-round trips from 2,643 ft. Valley Station to 8,516 Mountain Station on Mt. San Jacinto. Spectacular view. Wilderness trails.

**INDIO NATIONAL DATE FESTIVAL:** Every February. Ostrich and camel races, horse show, exhibits, Arabian Nights Pageant.

**SALTON SEA:** Begins 20 miles from Indio on State Hwy. 86 or 111. Fishing, swimming, boating. State park and private facilities for camping and picnicking.
